Travel within Washington state

Pay your standard in-network copay,

Travel in other Kaiser Permanente regions

Kaiser Permanente has medical facilities in California, Colorado, Georgia, Hawaii, Maryland, Oregon, Virginia, Washington state, and Washington, D.C. Before receiving care at a Kaiser Permanente facility outside the Kaiser Permanente Washington area, call Member Services to get a visiting member ID number.

Pay your standard in-network copay, coinsurance, or deductible at the nearest Kaiser Permanente location.

Access care online in another Kaiser Permanente region

Sign in at **kp.org** and add a new region of care from the drop-down menu. Once you confirm the region you would like to add, you will receive a success message, with a member number used to identify you in that region. This visiting member number should be used for scheduling or accessing in-person care in the new region.
